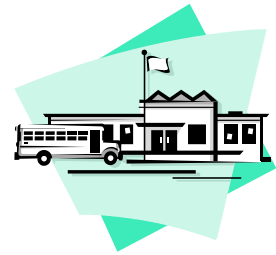

7	Principal's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Report cards went home in Feb and book fair was that night as well - Didn't do as well as in the past, so they may move it back to - Black History month events occurred this month - They focussed on Black Joy across the Board - They had special announcements throughout the month - The focus was also on Black Canadians - Girls Volleyball pod tournament was here but - Jr. Boys Volleyball went on to the Families - Sr Girls Basketball is running now and one of the teachers parents is volunteering to teach skills and coach the team - Liturgy was held by Mrs Jones substitute teacher - Students in Grades 1 – 8 had an assembly re school expectations on respect and kindness - School wide presentation on African instruments and how and why they were made; it was all about love and then there were dancers up there and then brought the teachers up there to sign and dance as well - BHM liturgy was also ran by the YFA's - Math pod professional learning had 2 lessons that they had to do with students to see where they see math and having a discussion about where is math after they walked around the school; they made connections to various life areas of where math lives; they don't see math everywhere so they had a discussion about how they can change that view of math; it was good to get together with teachers from different schools to gain the different perspectives - Positive office referral program has begun to recognize any student where any staff member can find an area where a student did something great and each week a student will have a chance to have a treat with the teacher; when the kids come down they can sign there name; - March the Virtue is Kindness and the Mental Health and Wellness committee is going around the school to hide purple ducks and once you find one then they give you a heart with a kindness mission on the heart then they will receive a kindness sticker; - Rosary Apostolate on March 5th and the Big Gulp is March 5th - The Big Crunch on March 22nd, - Pretzels for lent is March 28th - Good Friday March 29th - April 8th is the revised PA Day - Wed June 26th during the day is graduation; ceremony at Le Trepoort 9:30am then pics; then families will leave and students stay for lunch and dance and end approximately 2:30; cost will be \$55 per person - Grad trip is also confirmed and all the kids are going - 	Ms. Laporte
