7	Principal's Report /Ministry Updates	School Updates: On Monday, November 16 th students began a new learning model – either Hybrid or Remote. Students in the Hybrid model can move in and out of the classroom when parents find it necessary – re. child is sick, worried about the covid-19 numbers, etc. Those students have a teacher from St. Veronica. Students in the Remote model have a teacher for the remainder of the year who may or may not be a St. Veronica teacher. Currently we are hosting 3 remote classrooms at the school: JK/SK – Mrs. de Leon and Ms. Giraldo Grade 2 – Mrs. De Carvalho Grade 5 – Ms. Fung When Mr. Dolan received the Board's reorg. Plan for our school we had to make many changes – some in classroom grades, teachers, students, and classroom locations. To date and for the remainder of the year the classes are as follows: JK/SK – Mr. LeClair and Ms. Ponte SK/1 – Mrs. Occhiuto 1 – Mrs. Ryan 2 – Mrs. Moroney	K. Dolan

Other staff were also affected in terms of Planning Time, FSL, ESL, French and Library.

We are waiting for additional technology that we ordered to be delivered to our school. We have ordered webcams, headsets, speakers, and cables to support the teachers with their teaching on-line students. Principals were instructed that these funds need to come out of our school operating budget. Roughly the cost will be around \$6.400.

In terms of technology we have provided chrome books to families learning at home. We have requested additional chrome books/laptops to support our students at school so that all can have access to devices at school. With covid-19 each student requires a device as we would prefer not to share as we must sanitize the device each time it moves to another student.

New Technology – This can be ordered now but the drawback is it will probably take a year to receive.

Parish: Father Stefano was visiting the classes every Thursday but due to the rise of cases of covid-19 he can no longer make school visits.

Rosary Apostolate – We have spoken to the Rosary Apostolate and it was mentioned that we can access You Tube videos to pray the rosary. This info. will be relayed to the teachers with the links they can access.

Virtues: We are still waiting to hear back from our contact about the virtue tokens. We would like to begin the process of awarding the students in each class who demonstrate the virtues each month. We wanted to wait until after we had our re-org.

X-Movement: To support student well-being a year subscription to the X-Movement was purchased. There are

various activities students can do in class with their teacher around wellness and mindfulness, - yoga, meditation, sports, etc. This subscription also enables parents to connect from home so that the remote students do not miss out. The link was sent to Mrs. Villers to share with you in case you have not seen it yet.

Water Refill Station – Bottle filling stations replace existing water fountains; board technician must visit the school to check installation feasibility. The estimate to perform the work is \$2 139.03 for a single bottle filing station and approximately \$500.00 for the material installation.

Mt. Dolan poke to the Principals at St. Julia and St. Barbara regarding religious tokens and fundraising. St. Julia thought the idea of holding off until the next groups receives the sacraments would be a good idea. Also, they are fundraising with Terra Cotta Cookies through school cash online. St. Barbara is not fundraising and is not sending out religious tokens.

Remembrance Day was on November 11th. Mr. Dolan read the students some info. regarding why we have Remembrance Day and why we need to pay tribute to the men and women who have fought for our freedom and currently serve our country. Prior to 11:00 a.m. We played Taps over the P.A. and at 11 we observed two minutes of silence. Teachers also did activities in their classroom.

Hold and Secure – On Wednesday, Nov. 18th we had a Hold and Secure. There was police involvement in the area regarding some fireworks they found near the school. Everything went well. Signs were placed on the doors to indicate that no one could enter or exit the school. Info. was relayed to parents through e-mail and on Twitter. Also, as a follow-up Mr. Dolan sent a letter home to parents to let them know of the incident.

Christmas – As we approach Christmas there are a few families (four or five) that Mr. Dolan has spoken to our social worker about that we would like to support. In the past we have sent home a letter asking for gift cards to Walmart or one of the grocery stores. We then would buy cards and place the gifts cards inside for the families.

ShareLife – We may wish to consider making a donation to support ShareLife at this time.
